Havre de Grace Parks and Trails



Concord Point Park – Concord Point Park is a waterfront park overlooking where the Susquehanna meets the Chesapeake Bay, and the location of the Concord Point Lighthouse. A scenic spot that hosts several public art installations and attractions.



David Craig Park – 553-599 N. Union Ave: A small park along the water's edge, located at the entrance to downtown HdG on Union Ave. Home to the Sgt. Hilton Memorial.



Frank J. Hutchins Memorial Park – At the foot of Congress Ave. Public fishing and restrooms available. Enjoy great views of the Susquehanna River.



Graw Alley Park – 115 Market Street
A one acre interactive art park component of Harmers Town Art Center. Named in recognition of the former horse racing track that operated in the city a century ago. Sculptures, outdoor seating, and signage lead visitors on a tour of Havre de Grace history as told through a series of vivid murals and public art installations.



Joe K Trail/North Park/McLhinney Park – Grounds adjacent to the Lockhouse: Trail is 1.5 miles long, identified by white blazes. Part of three trail systems: 1) Lower Susquehanna Heritage Greenway 2) Mason Dixon Trail System 3) Loop Trail System in HdG's North Park. Playground at McLhinney Park.



K-9 Cody Dog Park – 100 Lagaret Ln. (behind the Havre de Grace Community Center). K-9 Cody dog park is a half-acre dog park with fenced in areas for both small dogs and large dogs. The park features a drinking fountain for both dogs and their owners.

Millard Tydings Memorial Park – Commerce St. Enjoy 8 acres overlooking the Susquehanna River, the HdG City Yacht Basin and the entrance to the Promenade. Park includes picnic areas, public restrooms, playground, pickleball court, and pavilion.



The Promenade – A scenic 3/4 mile boardwalk fronting the Susquehanna River and Chesapeake Bay. View interpretive signage about the Chesapeake Bay and the British attack on Havre de Grace during War of 1812. Open from dusk 'till dawn.



Susquehanna State Park – Located along the Susquehanna River, northwest of HdG
410-557-7994 . Recreational opportunities include fishing, boating, mountain biking, horseback riding, hiking, bird watching, picnicking, playground, camping, and the historic Rock Run Grist Mill.

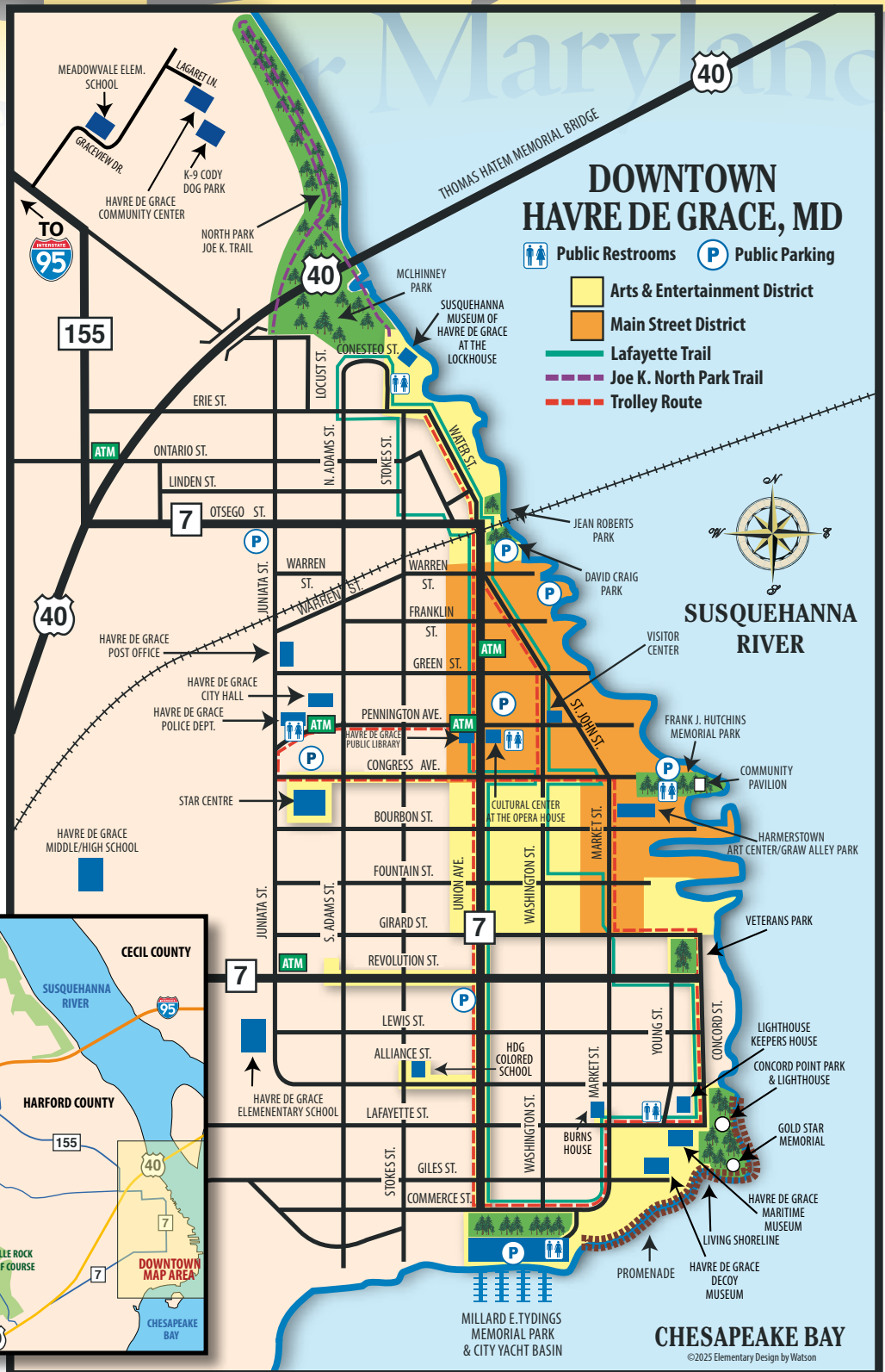
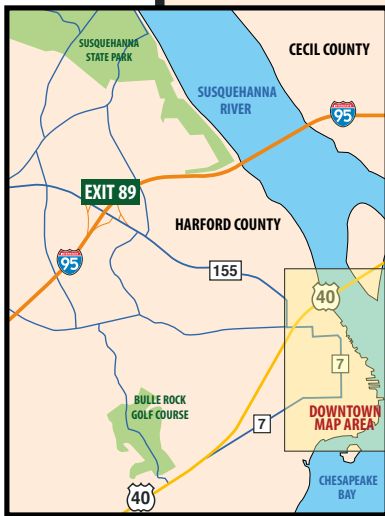

Arts & Entertainment District

Havre de Grace is home to a Maryland State designated Arts & Entertainment District. Recognized as a regional haven for artisans of all types, people are drawn to this area for its cultural and artistic flavor.

The **STAR Centre** plays host to musical performances, events, and athletic competitions. The **Cultural Center at the Opera House**, a renovated historic building, and the **State Theater of Havre de Grace** play host to a full calendar year of events including music, theater, film, dance and visual art. The City is also home to several art galleries, each with its own distinctive presentation of art.



Harmer's Town Art Center (HTAC) will be a first-of-its-kind regional art complex, art incubator, economic driver and tourist destination. The art complex has two components: a renovated 38,000-sq-ft building and an adjacent 1-acre outdoor interactive art park, **Graw Alley** (named

for the famous Graw racetrack). It leads visitors on a tour of Havre de Grace's rich history as told through a series of vivid murals and public art installations.

The **Havre de Grace Arts Collective, Inc.**, a local arts non-profit hosts popular events including poetry writing and other interpretive creative performances.

The downtown area, as well as several museums in the City, host numerous artistic presentations and exhibits. Restaurants offer musical entertainment regularly. **First Fridays**, a downtown street festival, provides a backdrop for musicians and performers of all types and is attended by thousands May through October.
